SIENA/FRANCIS HOUSE “MIRACLES” RECOVERY PROGRAM

If you are homeless, served in the United States military, and suffer from addiction to alcohol, drugs, or have other addiction(s), you are encouraged to seek help from the Siena/Francis House’s “Miracles” Recovery Program.

The “Miracles” Recovery Program is an in-patient, residential addiction recovery program for persons who wish to take this major life step, and is offered free of charge. Based on the traditional 12-Step recovery model, this program is open to any adult (19 years of age, or older) man or woman, who sincerely wants help in changing his or her life by abstaining from any addiction, including alcohol, narcotics, gambling, eating disorders, co-dependency, etc. Located on-site, and within the context of the Siena/Francis House’s homeless shelter at 17th & Nicholas Street in north downtown Omaha, the “Miracles” Recovery Program helps program participants to live a life of sobriety through involvement in individual and group counseling sessions, as well as other life-skill educational opportunities. Mental health assessments and mental health case management services are also available through the “Miracles” Recovery Program.

Any person who desires to participate in our “Miracles” Recovery Program must be willing to commit to stay a minimum of 120 days in our residential program, and to be involved with individual and group counseling and other life-skill-building educational classes, facilitated by licensed, professional addiction and mental health therapists. Classes include, but are not limited to: dual-diagnosed illnesses; grief recovery; dysfunctional beliefs; women’s trauma; anger management and relapse prevention.

In helping create an environment in which program participants might find successful sobriety in their lives, all program participants are also assigned a job/position in our organization’s employment training program. This employment training component of the program requires all participants to provide a minimum of 32 service hours, per week, in support of the functioning of our shelter. Employment training positions include: staffing our front desks; shelter; kitchen; pantry; loading dock; Day Services Center and Maintenance Department.

As a person in our “Miracles” Recovery Program becomes successful in all aspects of his/her recovery, our staff helps him or her identify and obtain resources related to housing, employment, education, “aftercare” and other benefits, in order to successfully manage his or her life in a sober environment.

Graduation is the final step of the Siena/Francis House’s “Miracles” Recovery Program. All graduations are held at the Siena/Francis House’s community meeting, held from 10:00 until 11:30 a.m. every Friday morning in the dining room of our Baright Shelter. There is no predetermined, maximum time limit for participants to complete/graduate from our “Miracles” Recovery Program.
