

Shelter and Life-Changing Support on the Path to Safe, Permanent Housing



Siena Francis House leads the movement to end homelessness with these evidence-based programs for our most vulnerable neighbors.

Emergency Shelter Meals

Providing shelter to men and women experiencing homelessness 7 days a week, 365 days a year. Three meals a day are provided to shelter guests, and meal service is available to anyone in need.

Permanent Supportive Housing

The Siena Apartments and The Cottages are the bedrock of Siena Francis House's Permanent Supportive Housing program. These co-located units provide affordable efficiency units and support services to individuals who have a disability and were once chronically homeless.

Miracles Addiction Treatment & Recovery Program

Providing residential addiction treatment through a 12-Step model, free to adults who are experiencing homelessness or are at-risk due to substance abuse disorders.

Street Outreach

Meeting the immediate needs of people experiencing homelessness in unsheltered locations, with emergency shelter, housing and critical services. Delivering urgent, non-facility-based care.

Case Management

Case managers work with individuals to help them navigate the social service system and, ultimately, achieve permanent housing in the community.

Amy Breaks the Cycle of Homelessness and Addiction with Siena Francis House



Amy lived in her truck for years. Weighed down by addiction and trauma, she drifted from place to place. "I felt trapped in a seemingly endless cycle, where each day felt like the last, and with no way out," Amy said.

But after our Street Outreach team helped her get off the streets and enroll in the Miracles Addiction Treatment & Recovery Program, she began a new cycle — one of healing and renewed hope.

"We knew we had to get Amy into safe housing. Then, the other pieces could fall into place," said Mandy Rose, case manager. With shelter and a sense of stability, Amy felt safer and more secure to work through her trauma, face her addiction, and learn how to navigate life in sobriety.

"I want to be a source of inspiration for others walking a similar path and remind them that it's possible to turn your life around."

This approach puts Siena Francis House at the forefront of ending homelessness and effectively addressing its root causes — including addiction.

After graduating from the Miracles program, Amy has maintained housing, found a job, and spends much of her time encouraging others. "I know how important it is to have a strong network," she said. "I want to be a source of inspiration for others walking a similar path and remind them that it's possible to turn your life around."
